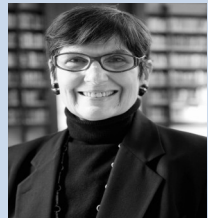

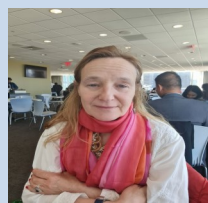
Gail Small Esq.
